

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with these label directions.

GENERAL: Read label first. Limited to crack and crevice wall void and spot treatment only in areas where food is prepared. May be used as a space spray elsewhere. Food Processing Areas: Cover or store away food and all processing surfaces and utensils so they are protected during treatment, or wash thoroughly before use. In homes, hospitals, hotels, schools, etc. remove all people and pets and cover aquariums before spraying. Allow two (2) hours ventilation time before they return.

HOW TO USE AS A SPACE SPRAY: As stated above remove all people and pets first. Take any necessary measures to clean up food, remove or anything else that would attract insects. Close off ventilation and spray at a rate of 3 seconds (1 oz.) per 1000 cubic feet area (100-125 square feet) to be treated. Aim spray at cracks and crevices, under sinks in cabinets and closets, behind curtains and underneath furniture using short bursts. Finally spray into or at a 45 degree angle for 2-4 seconds, or until room is filled with mist, contacting as many insects as possible.

FLYING INSECTS: Use as above, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as needed.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Use as above directing spray behind stoves, showing refrigerators, cabinets, processing equipment under sinks in cracks and crevices, and anywhere these insect pests are suspected of harboring. Contact as many exposed insects as possible. Repeat as needed.

AREAS OTHER THAN THOSE IN COMMERCIAL FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: To kill insects found on front porch spray into cracks and crevices wall boards, baseboards and other places insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, under stoves, refrigerators, coffee makers, pipes, drain areas and in and around waste containers for spot treatment. Directly contact as many insects as possible with small amounts of this product. Use activators or equipment capable of delivering a jet-thin stream to joints between different elements of construction such as door frames, window frames, meter boxes, drain openings leading to vents and hollow spaces in walls, between equipment and floors or bases, etc. Follow trails of ants or other insects and spray into areas in walls where they hide. Repeat as necessary.

PEST CONTROL IN FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS, FOOD STORAGE AREAS, RESTAURANTS, AND OTHER FOOD HANDLING PLACES (OTHER THAN PRIVATE RESIDENCES IN WHICH EXPOSED FOOD IS HELD, PROCESSED, PREPARED OR SERVED):

NON-FOOD AREAS: Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (no sewers), drains and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, may, etc. Apply to cracks and crevices, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath auto, factory, window and door screens, labels, pipes, and similar areas where insects hide or nest and areas through which they may enter.

FOOD AREAS LIMITED TO CRACK & CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY: Apply a small amount of material as a jet-thin stream directly into cracks and crevices such as expansion joints, between different elements of construction or between equipment bases and the floor, wall vents or hollow equipment legs where the insects nest above. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces of introducing the product into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

CARPET BEETLES & DERMESTID: Spray along baseboards, edges of carpeting and rugs, under furniture in closets or showing and in other places of harborage. Repeat as necessary.

BUG TICKS & FLEAS: Remove and destroy old bedding. Vacuum all carpets and throw away the bag. Clean infested laundry and linens, shut off ventilation. Spray no closer than two (2) feet away from the sleeping quarters of pets around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local floor areas. Repeat as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spray has dried. To control the source of your flea infestation treat your pets with a product registered for application to animals. DO NOT spray animals with this product.

TERMITES, CARPENTER ANTS & OTHER WOOD DESTROYING INSECTS: For control of carpenter ants in homes and other structures, spray around doors and windows and other places where carpenter ants enter the premises and where they crawl and hide. Also spray into cracks and crevices or through openings of small newly drilled holes into wall voids where ants or their nests are present. For control of termites apply to voids and channels in damaged wood. Treatment of localized areas is intended to kill workers and winged reproductive forms of termites in the treated areas and to prevent recolonization for a temporary period. This type of application is not intended to be a substitute for soil treatment or mechanical alteration to control subterranean termites.

APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT IS NOT PERMITTED.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of treated areas after treatment. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Do not spray toward face. Remove people and animals before spraying. Avoid contamination of food, feed or foodstuffs. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until areas are dry. Remove clothing and wash if it becomes contacted with spray. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water after using.

IF POISONING OCCURS: Dial 911 or contact a Poison Control Center immediately. Keep this can in your possession, especially if you go to a hospital.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS: Non-flammable solvent and propellant under pressure. Do not puncture can or expose to flame. Do not incinerate can. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Avoid excessive spraying of vinyl or tile flooring and varnished or painted surfaces as this product can cause staining or marring of finishes. Do not inject directly into electrical equipment such as radio televisions, etc.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep locked in a cool and dry storage area away from heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty container and put in trash.
