GENERAL Read label first. Expressly for crack and crevice spot and inaccessible void (attics, false ceilings, wall voids) treatment. Propoxur 200 is intended for use with injection tube and/or professional equipment. Place extension tube into cracks, crevices, holes, and other openings and dispense slowly. Remove people, pets, and cover aquariums before spraying this product. Keep children and pets away from treated areas until spray has dried.

USE OTHER THAN THOSE IN COMMERCIAL FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS To kill insects hiding in wall voids, spray into cracks and crevices, wall voids, baseboards and other places insects hide. Do not spray behind and beneath cabinets, sinks, stoves, refrigerators, coffee makers, pipes, damp areas, and in or around waste containers. For spot treatment, directly contact as many insects as possible with small amounts of this product. Use actuators or equipment capable of delivering a pin stream to points between different elements of construction such as door frames, window frames, meter boxes, drains, and pipes leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, between equipment and floors or bases. Follow directions for ants or other insects and inject spray into areas in walls where they hide. Repeat as necessary.

CONTROL IN MEAT PACKING AND FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS, FOOD STORAGE AREAS, RESTAURANTS, AND OTHER FOOD HANDLING PLACES (OTHER THAN PRIVATE RESIDENCES IN WHICH EXPOSED FOOD IS HELD, PROCESSED, PREPARED OR SERVED) Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, remove any exposed food and cover processing equipment during application. Wash thoroughly all food utensils before their use. Do not apply while food processing is in progress.

RESIDENTIAL FOOD AREAS Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, closets, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets storage (after canning or bottling) and warehouses where food is not exposed. Apply to baseboard areas, cracks and crevices, under water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, window and door screens, tables, and similar areas where insects hide or rest and areas through which they may enter.

USE LIMITED TO CRACK & CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY. Apply a small amount of material as a pin stream directly into cracks and crevices such as expansion joints between different elements of construction, or between equipment bases and the floor, wall voids, or hollow equipment legs where insects are noted above. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing equipment.

SPRING BEETLES & DERMESTIDS Spray along baseboards, edges of carpeting and rugs, under furniture, in closets, on shelving, and in other places of harborage. Repeat as necessary.

SPRING BEETLES & FLEAS Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, walls and local floor areas. Repeat as necessary. Remove and destroy old bedding. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spray has dried. To control the source of your flea infestation, treat your pets with a product registered for application to animals. DO NOT SPRAY ON ANIMALS.

SPRING BEETLES, CARPENTER ANTS & OTHER WOOD DESTROYING INSECTS: For control of carpenter ants and other structures, spray around doors and windows and other places where carpenter ants enter the premises and where they crawl and hide. Also spray into cracks and crevices or through openings of small, newly drilled holes into wall voids where ants or their nests are present. For control of termites, apply to voids and channels in damaged wood. Treatment of localized areas is intended to kill termites and winged reproductive forms of termites in the treated areas and to prevent infestations for a long period. This type of application is not intended to be a substitute of soil treatment or chemical alteration to control subterranean termites.
