

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS (AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS)
CAUTION**

At the recommended dosage Captan 300 Flowable Seed Protectant is noninjurious to seeds or seedlings and the germination of treated seed is frequently stimulated, giving a superior result as compared to results from untreated seed.
