

### HERPICIDE SPRAY

Kills Herpes simplex type 1 and type 2 viruses on hard, inanimate environmental surfaces in 10 seconds. It provides 24 hours of residual virucidal activity against Herpes simplex type 1 and type 2 for four uses, in the presence of moisture, for contact time of 10 minutes if not removed from surface.

When applied to hard, inanimate environmental surfaces as directed and left on the surface for 10 minutes, HERPICIDE SPRAY is also virucidal against Influenza A2/Japan, Influenza B, Adeno virus type 2, Polio type 1, and Vaccinia V506; bactericidal against Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis and fungicidal against Trichophyton mentagrophytes.

FOR USE IN HOMES, HOSPITALS, NURSING HOMES, VETERINARY CLINICS, DOCTORS OFFICES, SCHOOLS, OFFICES, PLANTS, STORES, MOTELS, HOTELS AND PUBLIC REST ROOMS.

Spray regularly on toilet seats, sinks, showers, bath tubs, handles, switches, tables, chairs, telephone, mirrors, empty waste receptacles, floors and walls.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of the federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Remove gross filth or heavy soil from the surface prior to application. Remove child resistant cap from the Herpicide spray container and install pump spray unit. Hold container upright 6 inches away from the surface and pump the spray unit until the contaminated surface is thoroughly wet for 10 minutes then air dry. Remove the pump spray unit. Re-seal container with the child resistant cap and close tightly before storage.

For Herpes simplex type 1 and type 2 viruses spray the surface until thoroughly wet for 10 seconds then air dry.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD, OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL. Store only in tightly closed, original container in an area inaccessible to children and away from heat and open flames.

Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse container before discarding in trash.

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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS: Causes severe eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Wear safety glasses or goggles when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food or feed.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of gelatin solution, or raw egg whites or, if these are not readily available drink a large quantity of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.
