#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This vegetation killer can be applied prior to or up to 3 months after weed emergence. Application rates vary from 1 to 4 gals. of this vegetation killer per 1000 sq. ft. depending on climatic conditions, soil type, the weeds present and the stage of growth of the weeds. In the following rate recommendations, the higher rates are intended for use on heavier soils where weed growth is heavy and where rainfall is expected to be relatively high. The higher rates should also be used where longer residual control is desired in regions with a longer growing season.

**For control of annual and susceptible perennial weeds:** Apply 1 to 1 1/2 gals. of this vegetation killer mixed in a minimum of 10 gals. of water per 1000 sq. ft. to give thorough and long-term coverage.

**For control of hard-to-kill perennial weeds and grasses:** Apply 3 to 4 gals. of this vegetation killer mixed in a minimum of 20 gals. of water per 1000 sq. ft. to give thorough and long-term coverage.

**For faster top-kill of existing vegetation:** Apply this vegetation killer in diesel oil, fuel oil or weed oil. Use 1 1/2 to 2 gals. per 1000 sq. ft. (100-200 gals. per acre). The dense vegetation will generally require 1 1/2 to 2 gals. per sq. ft. (150-200 gals. per acre) or more of oil for thorough coverage.

This vegetation killer is a non-selective herbicide that can be applied in water or oil before or after plant growth begins. Although this vegetation killer has considerable activity through foliar contact, much of its activity is through roots. Therefore, its effectiveness is dependent on adequate rainfall to move it into the root zone.

Care must be taken to keep this herbicide away from desirable flower beds, lawns and shrubs. Do not apply over roots of valuable trees or woody ornamental plants. Only apply this herbicide outside the dripline of trees. Avoid spray drift to desirable plants.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide spray mixture or rinsate that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal, state or local procedures.
