On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Make the following label changes:
 - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 48963-3".
 - b. We have found that products of this type may have an adverse effect on puppies or kittens under 3 months of age. Your phrase is not the one we recommended in our letter of February 23, 1993. Please either change the phrase to what we recommended or provide convincing information why your label should be different from what we normally accept.
 - c. Remove from the Precautionary Statements "Avoid breaching vapors" and remove "skin" from the statement "Avoid contact with skin or eyes".

2d. Change the "IF IN EYES" statement to read "Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists."

2e. Move the 0.10% for Pyrethrins to a position over the other percentages shown.

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

YIPPEE Pet Shampoo is a clear emulsion that combines the properties of a detergent, deodorizer, hair dressing and insecticide. The special detergents used possess a quick sudsing and foaming action. The stable foam generated by these cleaning components provides the pesticides with a longer residence time in contact with your pet's hair, skin, etc. This contributes to a more effective removal of fleas, etc. and imparts that lustrous, soft feel to the coat.

TO USE

FLEAS - Thoroughly wet the animal with water and apply YIPPEE, about three tablespoonfuls for a medium or average size dog. Carefully work YIPPEE into the hair until a pronounced lather is formed over the entire body, rinse.

LICE - Apply in same manner as for fleas to kill motile or active stages of lice. To kill young lice that may have hatched from eggs repeat in one week. Use additional applications as needed.

TICKS - Apply with dropper, or piece of cotton, a small quantity of YIPPEE undiluted, directly on each individual American dog tick or Brown dog tick on dogs. Repeat the applications as necessary when animals acquire ticks.

CHIGGERS - Mites, commonly known as "Chiggers," "Red Bugs" or "Jiggers" often attach to the skin of dogs during the warm summer months. Use YIPPEE in the same manner as directed for Ticks.

NOTE - If YIPPEE is used on older cats they must be thoroughly rinsed & dried.
