

The following requirements or revisions apply to the label which was accepted with this registration notice:

1. The registration number which has been assigned to this product must appear on the label as EPA Reg. No. 48985-3.
2. On the right panel under "Apply to walls, floor and other hard (inanimate) surfaces..." revise "When use becomes visibly dirty" to "When use solution becomes visibly dirty."
3. The labels which will be used for this product in channels of trade must reflect these revisions.
4. Five copies of the finished printed labels, as defined in the A-79 enclosure, must be submitted to the Agency before the product is released for shipment to comply with PR Notice 82-2 of June 18, 1982.
5. The finished printed labels must comply with the general labeling requirements of Section 162.10 of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations. Failure to do so may result in rejection of the labels.

Cross-contamination is of major housekeeping concern in schools, medical institutions, and industry. It has been formulated to aid in the reduction of cross-contamination in these areas.

It is a one-step disinfectant cleaner that is effective against a broad spectrum of bacteria, is fungicidal, and will prevent the growth of mold and mildew and their odors when used as directed.

It is an effective one-step sanitizer-cleaner for use on non-food contact surfaces.

When used as directed, it will deodorize surfaces in toilet areas, behind and under sinks and counters, garbage cans and garbage storage areas, and other places where bacterial growth can cause mal odors.
