BABY'S LAUNDRY: Diapers, sheets and rubber garments. **WHITE COTTONS AND LINENS:** Bleach is best used in first rinse after washing add one tablespoon (1 1/2 fl oz) of bleach for each gallon of warm water, then immerse clothes for 15 min. rinse in cold water. For **AUTOMATIC WASHERS:** mix one fluid ounce of bleach for each gallon of water and pour slowly at wash period.

In Soak suds add 1 tablespoon bleach for each gallon cold or warm water, mix well, add soap or sudsing powder. Immerse clothes 1/2 hour to overnight.

FAST COLORED GARMENTS: Use only 1/2 tablespoon bleach for each gallon of water.

NOTE: This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage, as necessary, to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or discard by placing in trash collection or burying in an approved landfill. Product or residue that cannot be used, should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
