

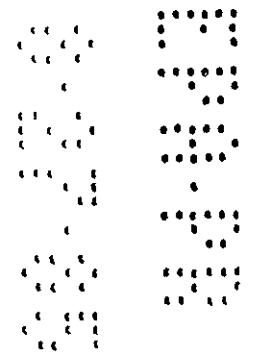

feed automatically, ready for next use. When through using,

keep small center cap closed to prevent moisture loss. To

disinfect inanimate, clean, hard, non-porous surfaces such

as chairs, counters, trays, drawer pulls: Thoroughly wipe

contaminated surface with wet towelette and allow it to dry.
