2. **For Disinfection:** Before disinfecting, pre-clean the surface as in Step 1 above. Then, apply enough fresh solution to thoroughly wet the surface. Allow the disinfecting solution to contact surfaces for 10 minutes before wiping or rinsing the treatment from the surfaces.

3. **For Mildew:** Follow directions for disinfection. Repeat treatment every 2 weeks or when mildew growth first re-appears.

***NOTE:** This product may be used on food contact surfaces, but surfaces must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water before they are permitted to re-contact food.


