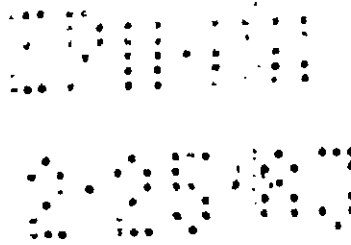

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE  
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT  
IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING

**LAUNDERING IN TUB, WASHING MACHINE OR AUTOMATIC WASHER**  
**IN SUDSING SUDS**—Add 1 tablespoon of this sodium hypochlorite solution for each gallon of water. Add 1 scoop of detergent. Immerse laundry 15 min. to overnight. Wash twice.

**IN WASHING SUDS**—Add 1 tablespoon of this sodium hypochlorite solution for each gallon of water. Mix well. Add scoop of detergent. Immerse laundry. Wash. Rinse. For automatic washers, add laundry before water is added. Dilute recommended amount of this sodium hypochlorite solution in 1 qt. of water and pour into water after laundry is immersed.

**BLEACH, DISINFECTANT, DEODORANT, STAIN REMOVER OR CLEANSER**  
To remove STAINS—Fruit, Berry, Wine, Coffee, Tea, Chocolate, Vegetable, Flower, Grass, Blood and many Ink, Dye and Medicine Stains, also SCUFFS and MILDEW (Do not use on silk, wool or unfaded colors)—Make solution 2 tablespoons of this sodium hypochlorite solution for each qt. of cold water. Mix thoroughly. Immerse fabric 5 to 15 min. Rinse well in clear water. Repeat if necessary. Any trace of mildew remaining usually disappears when fabric is dried in sunlight.

**FOR SANITIZING GLASSES, DISHES AND SILVERWARE**  
Immerse for 30 seconds in solution of 2 oz. of this sodium hypochlorite solution to 4 gallons of water in final rinse (see dishwashing procedure). This product may be employed in hot or cold water.

Eating and drinking utensils properly washed and submerged in product solution prepared as directed will be sanitized in accordance with health department requirements.

For disinfectants: 4 tbsps. or 2 oz. of this sodium hypochlorite solution added to 1 gallon of water equals 200 ppm available chlorine solution. 8 ozs. equals 1 one cup solution.

**NOTE:** This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage as necessary to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. It may be cleaned up thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or discarded in a trash container or buried in an approved landfill. Products are made the safe way. They should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
