The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted subject to the comments reflected on the enclosed sheet. A copy of your proposed labeling stamped "ACCEPTED WITH COMMENTS" is enclosed.

WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted the labeling changes that are necessary to comply with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K, described in PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11. Any other labeling changes submitted in connection with this amendment application but not directly related to compliance with the WPS have not been reviewed or accepted by the Agency. If you wish to make such changes, you must submit a separate amendment application proposing them. If your product is currently suspended, the acceptance of this labeling amendment does not affect the suspension in any way.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO NEXT:

By the next label printing make all the specified changes to your labeling. Send to EPA one (1) copy of the final printed labeling:

- BEFORE selling or distributing any product bearing the final printed labeling
- AND
- WITHIN one year from date of this acceptance.



DE BUG 5% CARBARYL BAIT

The following specific comments pertain to your
WPS labeling submission concerning the product
cited above:

Add the following statement to the "Personal Protective Equipment" section of your label: "Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry." The exact location for this statement is shown in Section A on Part 1 of the Product Worksheet in Supplement Three-A to PR Notice 93-7.

Remove the statement "Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application." from its current position within the Agricultural Use Box and place it above the Agricultural Use Box.

You incorrectly changed the active ingredient statement. Leave the active ingredient the way it is on your current label. Show the product type identifier as "N-methyl carbamate" according to the instructions on Page 33 of Supplement 3 (PR Notice 93-7).

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: 1 Naphthyl Methylcarbamate is a moderate reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

Personal Protective Equipment: Applicators and other handlers must wear:

- A. Long-sleeved shirt and long pants
- B. Waterproof gloves
- C. Shoes plus socks

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic and estuarine invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Prohibitions: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

Storage: Store unused DeBug 5% Carbaryl Bait in original container only, in cool, dry area out of reach of children and animals. Do not store in areas where temperatures frequently exceed 100 degrees F.

Pesticide Disposal: Waste resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on-site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Empty bag completely into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Read entire label. Use in strict accordance with label directions and cautions.

GENERAL: Broadcast application may be made with spreader, hand applicator, aircraft or by hand. Use gloves and wash thoroughly following application. Treatment may be repeated as necessary.

CROP AND RANGELAND: Apply 2 to 10 pounds per acre for control of grasshoppers, crickets and cutworms.

HOME AND GARDEN: Use 1/2 to 2 1/2 pounds per 10,000 square feet of area. Use the higher application rates when insect density is high and crops or garden are threatened.

FOR SUPPRESSION of grasshoppers and crickets, rates of 1/2 to 2 pounds per acre may be used.
