This is in response to your amendment to update label and active ingredient statement to comply with agency specifications.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the following comments.

1. In the ingredient statement, the declared percentage of 72% should be aligned with the chemical name of the active ingredient with the heading Active Ingredient. See below.

Active Ingredient:  
o-benzyl-p-chlorophenol .... 72%  
Inert Ingredients: ..... 28%  
Total 100%

2. Revise the ingestion statement to read: "If swallowed, drink large amounts of water. Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician or poison control center immediately."
3. Revise the first sentence in the "Environmental Hazard" section to read: "This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms."

The confidential statement of formula dated September 28, 1988 is in compliance with PR Notice 91-2, it agrees with the revised label's label claim and is acceptable.

### Statement of Practical Treatment
