The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under section of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

Proposed Amendment

- a minor change to the basic formulation [see confidential statements of formula (CSF) dated 10/15/04]
- revised labeling

**Conditions**

Revise the label as follows:

1. Add the subheading **Pesticide Storage** and appropriate text to the Storage and Disposal Section. Note that the registrant is responsible for developing the storage instructions. Refer to PR Notice 83-3 for detailed information.
2. Correct the spelling of the word *statemetns* to "Statement" in the text "see side panel for additional precautionary statements."
3. Revise the text under the product name to read similar to the following:

**"FOR MANUFACTURING USE ONLY"**  
**"For Formulating disinfectant end use products"**

4. The precautionary statement heading must be in the same type size as follows:

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS  
DANGER**

**General Comment:**


The revised basic CSF October 15, 2004 supersedes all previously accepted basic formulas.

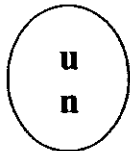
