The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable:

- to revise the "first aid" per PR Notice 2001-1
- add "total" to the ingredient statement

#### **Conditions**

Revise the label as follows:

- 1. Under the "Environmental Hazards" Statement revise the first sentence to read: "This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms".
- 2. Under the "First Aid" Statement add the following:

For Toxicity Category I eye and skin irritants, use the following "Note to Physician".

"Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage".

3. Delete the "s" on the word "Ingredients" in the Ingredient Statement.
