SANI PLUS Detergent Sanitizer is for use on food processing equipment including dairy and brewery equipment. It is also recommended for use on dishes.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Prepare a sanitizing solution by dissolving 1 oz. SANI PLUS Detergent Sanitizer in 100 oz. of water. This provides a solution containing 200 ppm of available chlorine. Remove and rinse items prior to sanitizing. The solution may be used on dishes, equipment or utensils in solution. Remove, rinse with potable water, and clean to remove gross soil. Then spread the sanitizing solution over the surface and stand 2-5 minutes and then rinse with potable water. The same solution may be used in immersion or spray type machines providing adequate contact time for sanitizing dishes, processing equipment and utensils. Rinse items with potable water and dry. The items are ready for use.

The sanitizing solution should be used as directed. If the solution is allowed to stand and tests show the level of chlorine has declined, additional SANI PLUS Detergent Sanitizer should be added to maintain a minimum of 100 ppm available chlorine.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in tightly closed container. Store in a cool dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of fire, isolate container if possible and flood with water to dissolve all material before disposal in trash collection or dispose in appropriate manner or bury in a safe place.
