Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling, and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or, using restroom. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

NOTE: One tablespoon of this product in a gallon of water is equivalent to 200 parts per million (ppm) available chlorine. This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage as necessary to obtain required level of available chlorine.

SANITIZING KITCHEN SINKS, REFRIGERATORS, COUNTER TOPS:

Preclean surface and rinse. Mix 1 tablespoon of this product with 1 gallon (3.785 L) of water and apply the sanitizing solution. Let stand for at least 2 minutes. Let dry.

DISINFECTING BATHROOM TILE, BATHTUBS, SHOWERS, FLOORS:

Preclean surface and rinse. Mix 3 tablespoons of this product with 1 gallon (3.785 L) of water and apply the disinfecting solution. Let stand for at least 10 minutes. Let dry.

FLOORS:

Add 1/3 cup (3 FL OZ) of this product to 1 ½ gallon of water, apply and let it dry.

TOILET BOWLS:

Prewash toilet and flush. Pour 1 cup of this product into the bowl. Brush entire bowl, including under the rim, and let solution stand for 10 minutes. Flush again. Do not mix or use with other household chemicals.

LAUNDRY USE:

Sort laundry by color and fabric. Use 1 cup of this product for a standard load, 1 ¼ cup for an extra large load. Add this product and detergent to wash water before adding laundry or use bleach dispenser.

Stains and heavy soil: Soak for 5 minutes in solution of ½ cup of this product to 9 fl. oz. of water, and then wash as usual.

Recommended for white and colorfast cotton, linen and polyester. Do not use on silk, leather, mohair, wool, non-fast colors and other fabrics not specified here. Do not use directly on clothes, dilute in water. To test fabric for colorfastness, mix 1 teaspoon of this product with ¼ cup of water and apply a drop to hidden portion of fabric. Let stand 1 minute and blot dry. No color change means the article can be bleached safely. Follow clothes manufacturer's instructions.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store this product in a cool dry area away from direct sunlight and heat to avoid deterioration. In case of spill, flood areas with large quantities of water. Product or rinsates that cannot be used should be diluted with water before disposal in a sanitary sewer. Do not reuse container but place in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
