**b. Labeling:**

1. The signal word is **CAUTION** based on the category III for Eye Irritation.
2. Precautionary Labeling:

### CLEANING – DEODORIZING:

**FLOORS:** Use ½ cup for every 2 gallons of water.

**GENERAL CLEANING:** Add ¼ cup for every ½ gallon of water to clean walls, stoves, outside of refrigerators, sinks, tubs, showers, and toilet bowls. For tough stains apply directly. Usually no rinsing required.

**DISINFECTING:** Preclean surface. Use this product full strength to kill gram negative bacteria in toilet, on floors, non-food contact kitchen and bathroom surfaces (includes walls, tubs, pet sleeping areas and garbage pails) and other hard, non-porous household surfaces. Apply with sponge, mop or cloth and thoroughly wet all surfaces. Let stand 10 minutes and air dry.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or open flame.
