SUPER K-GRO ROSE & FLORAL DUST

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ ENTIRE LABEL. USE STRICTLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH LABEL CAUTIONS AND DIRECTIONS.

SUPER K-GRO ROSE & FLORAL DUST has been formulated for the control of many insects and diseases on Roses and other flowers such as Chrysanthemums, Phlox, Gladioluses, Snapdragons, Irises, Carnations, Zinnias, Marigolds, and Asters.

APPLICATION: Before using, shake bottle and tap bottom lightly to loosen any settled product. Hold this container so that the discharge nozzle is pointed away from the face and body, then squeeze. Avoid standing in the path of the dust. For successful control of insects and diseases apply dust to all exposed plant parts, including the upper and lower leaf surfaces. For best results, apply dust in early morning or late evening when the temperature is low and the air is calm.

If the dust mixture being discharged becomes too "airy", we recommend the following steps: 1) shake the container lightly, 2) hold the container in a different position or angle and, 3) squeeze. NOTE: Be sure that the discharge nozzle is pointed away from the face and body.

CONTROL OF INSECTS: Apply dust when insects first appear or when damage to foliage is first noticed. Repeat application as necessary.

CONTROL OF DISEASES: Start a regular preventive program by dusting as soon as foliage appears. Under normal conditions, apply every 7 to 10 days during the growing season. Applications should be made twice a week during periods of rapid growth or during severe infection caused by frequent summer rains or high humidity. Treat at least once a week during periods of moderate infection. Apply it after a rainfall or watering with sprinkler.

IMPORTANT: Do not use on Boston Ivy or Japanese Maple. Do not use on certain species of Crassula (example: Jade Plant) or certain Ferns including Boston, M. Denhair and Platys. Do not use within 2 weeks of an oil spray treatment.

INSECTS & DISEASES CONTROLLED ON ROSES & OTHER FLOWERS:

Aphids, Spider Mites, Japanese Beetles, Rose Thrips, Rose Leafhoppers, Leaf Rollers, Rose Slugs, Lacebugs, Boxwood Leaf Miner, Sawflies, Scale Crawlers, Powdery Mildew, Leaf Spot and Black Spot.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Keep in original container, store in cool, dry place preferably in a locked area.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Generly pour original container into several layers of newspaper and direct to trash.

EMPTY PESTICIDE CONTAINERS: Do not reuse containers. Rinse thoroughly before discarding to trash.
