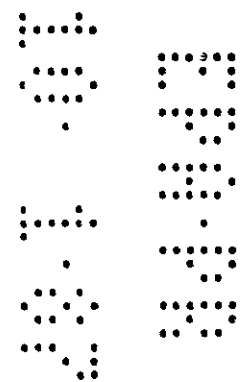

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

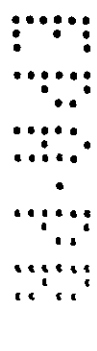

To Apply: Shake bottle. Hold container so discharge nozzle is pointed away from the face and body. Apply dust to all exposed plant parts, including the upper and lower leaf surfaces. Apply when temperature is low and air is calm. Apply dust when insects first appear. Repeat every 5 to 10 days or as necessary. For plant disease protection, apply dust as soon as foliage appears and repeat at 1 to 2 week intervals.

NOTE: Any residue on food crops should be washed off before use.

GARDEN PESTS: Aphids, leafhoppers, Flea Beetles, Colorado Potato Beetles (Except in CA), Cucumber Beetles, Mexican Bean Beetles (Except in CA). PLANT DISEASES: Septoria Leaf Spot, Anthracnose.

CANTALOUPE

Helps to control damage caused by Melon and Pickleworms.

STRAWBERRIES (7)*

GARDEN PESTS: Aphids, Leafhoppers. PLANT DISEASES: Botrytis Rot.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL
