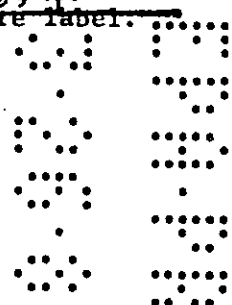

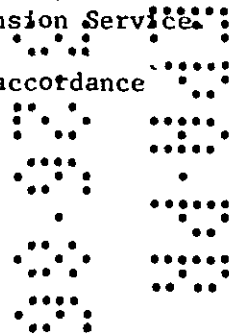

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ ENTIRE LABEL. USE STRICTLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH LABEL CAUTIONS AND DIRECTIONS.

This product has been formulated for the control of many insect pests on tomatoes, vegetables and ornamentals.

APPLICATION: Before using, shake bottle and tap bottom lightly to loosen any settled product. Hold this container so that the discharge nozzle is pointed away from the face and body, then squeeze. Avoid standing in the path of the dust. For successful control of insect pests, apply dust to all exposed plant parts, including upper and lower leaf surfaces. For best results, apply dust in early morning or late evening when the temperature is low and the air is calm. Always wash off any residue on food crops before use.

If the dust mixture becomes too "airy", we recommend the following steps:

- 1) Shake the container lightly,
- 2) Hold the container in a different position or angle and,
- 3) Squeeze.

FOR BEST RESULTS: Apply dust when insects first appear or when damage to foliage is first noticed. Repeat as necessary. Reapply after rainfall or watering with a sprinkler.

DOGS, CATS: Ticks, Fleas - Dust lightly over the animal and rub thoroughly into the skin. Apply to legs, on feet and between toes. Apply at weekly intervals. Avoid treatment of kittens and puppies less than 4 weeks of age. Dust lightly in and around kennels and dog houses. Repeat as necessary, but not more often than once weekly. NOTE: Do not allow treated pets back on carpets or rugs in house, as carbaryl insecticides may stain or discolor rugs and wall-to-wall carpets. DO NOT USE IN THE HOME. DO NOT APPLY TO RUGS AND CARPETS, AS STAINING MAY OCCUR.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep in original container. Store in a cool, dry place, preferably in a locked storage area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
