STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of throat. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF ON SKIN:** Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation develops. **IF IN EYES:** Flush with plenty of water. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to aquatic and estuarine invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

APPLICATION: Hold this container away from the face and body, then squeeze. Avoid standing in the path of the dust. Apply dust to all exposed plant parts, including upper and lower leaf surfaces. Apply dust in early morning or late evening when the temperature is low and the air is calm. Always wash off any residue on food crops before use. **FOR BEST RESULTS:** Apply dust when insects first appear or when damage to foliage is first noticed. Repeat as necessary. Reapply after rainfall or watering with a sprinkler.

Lettuce (head & leaf), Carrots	Flia Beetle, Harlequin Beetle, Leafhopper, Armyworm, Cabbage Caterpillar, Corn Earworm, Spinebug, Tarnished Plant Bug, Lygus Bug, Stink Bug	May be used on head lettuce up to 3 days before harvest, on leaf lettuce up to 14 days before harvest. Carrots — up to harvest.
Peppers, Potato, Eggplant	Colorado Potato Beetle, Flia Beetle, Leafhopper, Fall Armyworm, Tomato Hornworm, Tomato Fruitworm, European Corn Borer, Stink Bug, Lygus Bug, Tarnished Plant Bug, Lace Bug	May be used up to harvest.
Strawberries	Strawberry Leafhopper, Leafhopper, Spinebug, Lygus Bug, Flia Beetle	May be used up to 1 day before harvest.
Chard, Mustard Greens, Spinach, Swiss Chard	Flia Beetle, Stink Bug, Corn Earworm, Leafhopper, Armyworm	May be used up to 14 days before harvest.
Grapes	Grape Leafhopper, Grape Leaf Folder, Grape Berry Moth, Grape Leaf Skeletonizer, Japanese Beetle, June Beetle	May be used up to harvest.
