APPLICATION: Before using, shake bottle and tap bottom lightly to loosen any settled product. Hold this container so that the discharge nozzle is pointed away from the face and body, then squeeze. Avoid standing in the path of the dust.

For successful control of insects, apply dust only when insects are present and repeat as necessary. Apply dust uniformly to upper and lower leaf surfaces. For best results apply dust in early morning or late evening when the temperature is low and the air is calm.

If the dust mixture being discharged becomes too "airy", the following steps are recommended: 1) shake the container lightly, 2) hold the container in a different position or angle and, 3) squeeze.
