Dear Ms. Loft:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. In the list of claims beneath the product name, revise "Treats up to 5,000 sq. ft." to "Treats up to 2,000 sq. ft."
2. In the second line of the "RATES OF USE" table, revise "5,000 sq. ft./25/150" to "2,000/10/60."

The changes are necessary for a ten-pound container. The label as submitted would be acceptable for a 25-pound container.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

Apply [Super K-Gro Dursban 1/2G Granular Insecticide] uniformly to home lawns and other ornamental and recreational turf grass areas using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear.

To help obtain uniform distribution, apply one-half the required amount of product in one direction; then apply the balance at a right angle. Immediately after application, sprinkle the turf with water so as to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Consult the following table to determine amounts of [Super K-Gro Dursban 1/2G Granular Insecticide] and water needed. Re-treat as necessary, but not more often than once per every 7 days.

[MOUND TREATMENT] [FIRE ANT CONTROL:] To each Fire Ant mound, apply 4 oz. (one cup) evenly over and around each mound. [Treat each fire ant mound evenly applying one cup of granules over and around the mound.] For best results, apply granules during cool weather, 60° - 85°F or in early morning or

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late evening. Treat new mounds as they appear. It is not necessary to water in granules.

[WHITE GRUB CONTROL:] To control certain White Grubs (larvae of European chafer and Japanese beetle) use two to four times the amounts of [Super K-Gro Dursban 1/2G Granular Insecticide] suggested. Apply the granules uniformly over the area treated. For best results, immediately after application thoroughly water area to wash the insecticide into the turf. Treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface, usually during late July and August. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for proper time to treat in your area.

[HYPERODES (TURFGRASS) WEEVIL CONTROL:] To control Hyperodes (turfgrass) weevils use twice the rate of [Super K-Gro Dursban 1/2G Granular Insecticide] shown in the table. Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for best time to treat in your area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Keep in original container. Store in a cool, dry place preferably in a locked storage area inaccessible to children. **Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

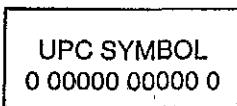
