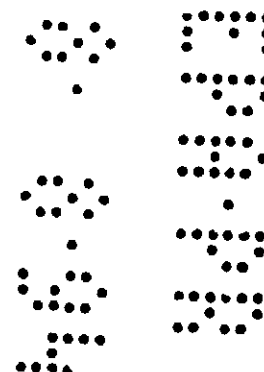

Apply [Super K-Gro Dursban Grub & Insect Control] uniformly to home lawns using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear.

To help obtain uniform distribution, apply one-half the required amount of product in one direction; then apply the balance at a right angle. Repeat application as necessary, but not more often than once per every 7 days. For best results, immediately after application sprinkle the turf with water to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Consult the following table to determine amounts [of Super K-Gro Dursban Grub & Insect Control] needed.

*Spreader settings are approximate. Accurately weigh a few pounds into your spreader and apply to a measured area. Then adjust the spreader setting, if necessary, in order to assure correct rate of application.

FIRE ANT CONTROL

To each Fire Ant mound, apply 4 oz. (one cup) evenly over and around each mound. **FOR BEST RESULTS:** Apply granules during cool weather, 60°-85°F or in early morning or late evening. Treat new mounds as they appear.

WHITE GRUB CONTROL (Larvae of European Chafer and Japanese Beetle)

To control certain White Grubs (larvae of European chafer and Japanese beetle) use two to four times the amounts [of Super K-Gro Dursban Grub & Insect Control] suggested. Apply the granules uniformly over the area treated. For best results, immediately after application thoroughly water area to wash the insecticide into the turf. Treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface, usually during late July and August. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for proper time to treat in your area.

HYPERODES (Turfgrass) WEEVIL CONTROL

To control Hyperodes (turfgrass) weevils use twice the rate [of Super K-Gro Dursban Grub & Insect Control] shown in the table. Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for best time to treat in your area.
