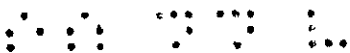

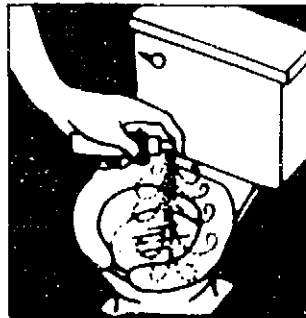

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To clean, deodorize, and kill herpes simplex type 1 and 2, hold dispenser 10 inches from the surface, press atomizer with quick, short strokes, spraying evenly until wet. Wait 50 seconds. Then wipe dry with tissue. To kill staph, strep and fungi repeat as above, wait 10 minutes and wipe dry.
