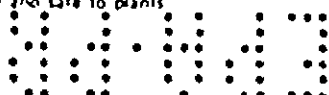
GENERAL INFORMATION

Apply this product only as specified on the label.

Do not use the product for any uses other than those specified on this label.

Sunbelt Wettable Sulfur is formulated for use in water as a spray on fruit, vegetable and ornamental crops for the control of certain fungus diseases and mites. It may be combined in the spray tank with most of the commonly used fungicides and insecticides.

Pour the specific amount of this product on surface of water in nearly full spray tank of 1/2 inch or 1/4 inch bucket, pouring into spray tank. Add balance of water to full tank. Keep agitator running during filling and spraying operations. Do not allow mixture to stand. Do not use in low volume gear type spray equipment. Do not combine with emulsifiable liquids unless previous use of the mixture has proven physically compatible and safe to plants.

CAUTION: Do not use sulfur in combination with an oil spray. Do not use sulfur on crops when shade temperatures exceed 100°F. Do not apply or allow sulfur to drift to Cucumbers, squash or lung. To do so may cause injury.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Consult State Agriculture Experiment Station Extension Service for additional information. Applications needed will vary with local conditions.

Directions given on this label are for dilutions in concentrate sprays. Increase the concentration factor. For example, if normally applied to one acre, the 5% concentrate would be applied to 5 acres. Spray often as needed.

IMPORTANT: Use the higher dosage during heavy rainfall. Spray often enough to keep foliage wet. This may require weekly or bi-weekly sprays for rapid growth and frequent rainfall. When using Sunbelt Wettable Sulfur, do not use Spray Lure, or other attractant, or use Arsenate without sulfur. When using Zinc Arsenate on peaches, always add Zinc Sulfate followed by Spray Lure. Lead Arsenate.

Apple, Pear: Powdery Mildew, Scab — of water in the pre-bloom, bloom and post-bloom cover sprays.

Cherry: Brown Rot, Spot — Use 6 to 8 lbs. in pre-bloom, bloom, petal fall, shuck, cover and post-harvest.

Others: Rust Mite — Use 5 lbs. per 100 gallons at first signs of damage and repeat as needed. Be controlled at all times of the year in fruit and green spot on leaves. Scale Control — each 100 gals. of tank strength lime sulfur.

Peach: Brown Rot, Scab — Use 6 to 8 lbs. in pre-bloom, bloom, shuck, cover and post-harvest.

Plum, Prune: Brown Rot, Leaf Spot — of water in pre-bloom, bloom, shuck, cover and post-harvest.

Beans, Peas: Powdery Mildew, Rust — of water for thorough coverage. Repeat intervals as necessary.

Peas: Black Spot Powdery Mildew — of water (3 to 4 tablespoons per 1 gal. of water) prior to first signs of disease and repeat throughout the season, repeating application when new growth protected.

Perennials, Shrubs: Powdery Mildew — 100 gallons of water (3 to 4 tablespoons) first application prior to first signs of disease schedule throughout the season, repeating every 7 to 10 days. Keep new growth protected.

WARRANTY STATEMENT

SUNBELT CHEMICALS, INC. warrants that the product in its unopened package conforms to the label and is reasonably fit for the purpose used according to directions under normal conditions. There are no other warranties, express or implied, in the use of this product other than indicated on the label. RE-ENTRY STATEMENT

Do not enter treated area without protective clothing and respiratory protection for 24 hours following application.
