### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use 65 mg per 2 oz. milk sample. Invert sample to mix. Do not overagitate. Preservo Powder should be used within one year from date of manufacturing and within three months after opening.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Powder should be stored in a dry area at temperatures under 80°F. Dessicate after opening. Keep away from: oxidizing materials, metals, sources of ignition, food and food containers, sunlight and fluorescent lights.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner and metal container in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. Desiccants may be removed and reused according to manufacturer's instructions.
