

7. Add "Respirator" to "Protective Equipment" in the "Directions" section.

8. Revise the respirator advice to read:

Always wear an organic respirator approved by NIOSH (the Safety and Health Administration) and NIOSH (National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health) under the provisions of 30 CFR Part 11.

9. Add "Do not apply within 30 days of harvest" to the "Time to Apply" blocks for "Apples, Cherries, Peaches," and "Peaches" in the fruit tree directions.

10. Add "Do not spray animals within 30 days of slaughter" in bold type directly under "Measure Accurately - Stir thoroughly before Use."

11. Add "under 3 months of age" to "Do not apply to young animals in the 'Lice on Hogs' direction. Note that a similar restriction against spraying calves under 3 months of age should appear in the various beef cattle use direction sections.

Print five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a special local label registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until April 30, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the existing stocks provision stated in our letter of October 20, 1983.

The attached supplemental statement of Florida showing additional information has been added to the product's registration file.
