

- f. For the label size submitted, the Storage and Disposal heading and the Child Hazard Warning "Keep Out Of Reach Of Children" would require a 12 point type size minimum and the signal word Danger (front panel only) would require an 18 point type size minimum.
- g. Include the statement, Statement of Practical Treatment, to appear directly below the signal word Danger (center panel only).
- h. The statement, "For Sale For Use And Storage By Maintenance Personnel Only" must be at least the same type size as the "Keep Out Of Reach Of Children" statement (front panel).
- i. Delete the statements:
 - or buried in a safe place.
 - or bury in a safe place.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
