DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION BY TRAINED SERVICE PERSONS

For a new pool or for spring start-up, superchlorinate with one (1) part (1%) of this sodium hypochlorite solution for each 3000 gallons of water. The dosage will raise to 5 ppm available chlorine by weight.

For Pool Maintenance

A) Adjust pool water pH to 7.6 - 7.8 range and maintain.
B) Add manually or by a feeder device this sodium hypochlorite solution to maintain an available chlorine residual of 0.8 to 1.0 ppm. One (1) part of this sodium hypochlorite solution for each 4500 gallons of water will provide 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight. Frequency of additions will vary. 1.0 ppm available chlorine will depend on temperature and pool circulation. Use test kit to make certain the pH and chlorine residual are in the proper range.

DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTION OF POTABLE WATER AT WATER TREATMENT FACILITIES

Dilute this sodium hypochlorite solution in the ratio of one part of solution to 10 parts of water. Add sodium hypochlorite solution to the water supply and maintain a residual of 0.5 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine throughout the distribution system as determined by a DPD chlorine test kit. Logistical sampling must be conducted at a frequency no less than that required by the National Sanitation Primary Drinking Water Regulations. Check water quality with a DPD chlorine test kit.

DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING FOOD PROCESSING OR DAIRY EQUIPMENT

Clean equipment in the normal manner. Just before using, immerse in a solution of 1% sodium hypochlorite (10 ppm available chlorine) for 10 minutes. Rinse thoroughly with water. Do not use after treatment with sodium hypochlorite solution. Do not use if the solution is older than 12 to 24 hours. This sodium hypochlorite solution will provide approximately 200 ppm available chlorine by weight.
NOTE: This product does not contain bleach. Use a chlorine test kit as necessary to determine the required level of available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store in a hot or direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Empty container thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or recycle through a hazardous waste disposal service. Do not use if the container is damaged.
