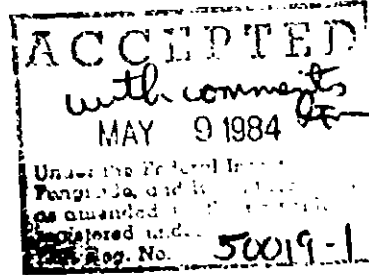

2. Apply MOSS-ION to lightly affected areas at the rate of one pound per 1,000 square feet. For heavier growth, apply over smaller area.
3. In two to four weeks, moss will turn from green to yellow to brown.
4. Removal of dead moss is not necessary because it will break down and gradually weather away.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and put in trash collection.

CAUTION: MOSS-ION is corrosive to copper.
