 and bathroom cabinets, bathroom dressers and chests of drawers, then squirt small amount in each drawer well.
 Necessary as necessary. Any pests visible after application must be present in cracks and crevices or removed. Apply only in
 areas inaccessible to children and pets. Avoid contamination of food and food stuffs.
 This product may be used in homes, restaurants and other food and food handling establishments, markets, schools, warehouses,
 factories, offices, hotels, motels, hospitals, nursing homes, garages, grocery stores, apartment buildings, new construction,
