

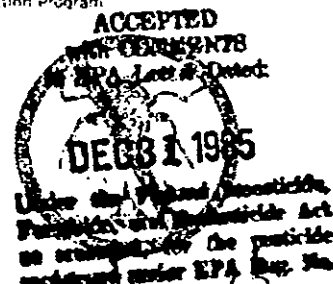

Keep for 15 minutes, then ventilate before re-occupy area.
