Agro Roach Tablets are an insect food and contain the Roach Lure. Because of this lure, roaches and waterbugs will find and eat these tablets. Tablets are made soft so that roaches and waterbugs may easily eat them. Place three tablets (whole, crushed or powdered) in light, unexposed areas, cracks, crevices and where roaches are seen. After feeding, roaches crawl off and die. Treat your entire home. Tablets must be placed in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Place tablets on shelves, drawers, closets, garbage cans, or attach with cellophane tape underneath cabinets. For maximum effectiveness, use the entire box and replace every six months.
