DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION

For new pools, in the spring start up, superchlorinate with one (1) pint of this product per 10,000 gallons of water. For each 2500 gallons of water, add 1/2 pint of this product to maintain a chlorine residual of 1.0 ppm.

POOL MAINTENANCE

At all times, maintain a chlorine residual of 1.0 ppm. Add 1/2 pint of this product per 2500 gallons of water to maintain a chlorine residual of 1.0 ppm. If the chlorine residual drops below 1.0 ppm, add more product. The frequency of adding will depend on the temperature of the water and the amount of bather load. Use test kit to make certain the pH is between 7.2 and 7.6.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat, fire, and moisture. Do not store with large quantities of water. Do not mix with water and other liquids. Do not pour into storm drains, sewers, or other water bodies. Do not use in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food, feed, or other animal products. Do not use equipment.
