

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DIRECTIONS: To clean and disinfect floors, and walls, tables, chairs, sinks and tubs, use 2 oz. per gallon of water. Remove gross filth and heavy soil, wet surface thoroughly with clean mop, sponge, or cloth. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes, and to air dry. For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required. On floors, it won't bluish or dull the shine as it cleans and disinfects at the recommended dilution. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

Kills HIV-1 (Human Immunodeficiency Virus Type 1) which causes AIDS (Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome) on cleaned Environmental Surfaces and Objects Previously soiled with Blood or Bodily Fluids.

Disposal of Infectious Materials: Blood and other bodily fluids should be disposed of according to local regulations for infectious waste disposal.

Use in hospitals, nursing homes, schools, food processing and service facilities, and other institutions. At 2 oz. per gallon of water, Fragrance Disinfectant is an effective disinfectant against:
