WILSON SLUG BAIT PELLETS are clean, highly compressed, and although attractive to snails and slugs, are deadly. When wet, the pellet will expand 3 times its size. Economical, 1 lb. of **WILSON SLUG BAIT PELLETS** covers 1000 sq. ft. Snails and slugs leave a mucous-like trail and look for damp, cool areas in gardens, bushes, around fences and under boards. They are nocturnal.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Keep pesticide in original container. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

SLUG BAIT PELLETS

DIRECTIONS: If ground is dry, wet thoroughly, area which is to be treated. Scatter pellets on areas to be treated, including flowers and plants. Rate one lb. of pellets covers 1000 sq. ft. Do not apply to foliage or plant parts. See back panel for directions for use around fruits and vegetables. Always wear protective gloves. Bait areas are likely to be infested at the beginning of the spring planting season before damage occurs. Treating about every 2 weeks will give adequate control, although additional treatments may be necessary if rainfalls occur. After application, sprinkle pellets with water, which will expand pellets into snail-attracting bait.

FRUITS AND VEGETABLES: To control snails and slugs around the following fruits and vegetables, apply to soil surface around the plants. Do not contaminate edible parts.

FRUITS: Apples, Avocados, Blackberries, Cherries, Citrus, Grapes, Peaches, Plums, Strawberries.

VEGETABLES: Asparagus, Beans, Beets, Cabbage, Carrots, Cucumbers, Eggplants, Lettuce, Melons, Onions, Peas, Peppers, Potatoes, Radishes, Spinach, Squash, Tomatoes and Turnips.

GREENHOUSES AND BATH HOUSES: Distribute pellets on and beneath benches but do not place in pots of flats unless plants are well established. Keep pellets from coming in contact with plants. If soil is dry, irrigate prior to or sprinkle lightly after distributing pellets.
