TO OPERATE: SHAKE BEFORE USING. Apply with the hand sprayer attached. Depress locking button on top and adjust nozzle to suitable spray pattern. Hold sprayer 18 inches from foliage and spray with circular motion. Direct spray so that upper and lower leaf surfaces are contacted. Use caution on new growth and tender foliage.
