DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

APPLICATIONS WITHIN FOOD AREAS:

Food processing plants and warehouses, bakeries, beverage plants, restaurants, supermarkets, meat and poultry processing plants, hotels, motels, hospitals, and schools.

Limit to Crack and Crevice Treatment Only:
 Using a bulbous duster apply a small amount of material directly into cracks and crevices such as expansion joints between different elements of construction or between equipment bases and the floor, wall voids, motor housing, junction boxes or switch boxes, conduits or hollow equipment legs where cockroaches, ants, silverfish, spiders, boxelder bugs, and crickets hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD ARE ESTABLISHMENTS, OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND NOT PERMITTED.

NON-FOOD AREAS:

Homes, institutions, hospitals, office buildings, hotels, warehouses, truck trailers and railroad cars. To control cockroaches, silverfish, firebrats, spiders, boxelder bugs, animal quarters, distribute Drione at the rate of 2 ounce area. Apply a continuous visible film underneath and behind appliances. Treat on, around and behind moldings, shelf openings, cracks, crevices, and other areas where insect infestations. Apply Drione behind cabinets and walls, in a rate of 16 ounces per 1000 square feet of surface area.

STORED PRODUCT PESTS:

To aid in the control of cadelles, cheese mites, cigarette beetles, dark meal worms, drugstore beetles, grain mite beetles, rice weevils, sawtoothed grain beetles and yellow elevators and granaries. Clean up waste materials, dust. Thoroughly treat floors, walls and other surfaces in bins. Apply into cracks and crevices and other difficult to reach hide.

BEES AND WASPS:

It is generally advisable to treat wasp and bee nests in the less active and have returned to the nest. Using hand or means, with extension tubes if necessary, thoroughly dust surrounding areas where insects alight. Nests in wall void with your ear against the wall. Drill a hole in the area, blow ground wasps, dust entrance and surrounding areas. For carefully one or two days after treatment to ensure complete destroy nest to prevent emergence of newly-hatched insects. If feasible, retreat the nest, if necessary. Do not use this product.

SEWER TREATMENTS:

American and Oriental cockroach infestations in sanitary approximately 6 ounces of Drione per manhole. When treated per 200 feet of line should be treated. Treatments are made by cover and replacing with a disc of plywood bored to receive from portable or truck-mounted ventilating equipment. 6 introduced into the ventilating air to be dispersed quickly system.

BEDBUGS:

Take bed apart. Dust into joints and channels. If hollow, see that the interior of framework is well dusted. Mattress tufts, folds, and edges. Picture frame moldings and all cracks should be treated.

DRYWOOD TERMITES

To protect against entrance, using an electric or hand operated Drione through an entry, e.g. crawl hole into attic and crawlspace. 1 pound per 1000 square feet of floor area. All vents and should be closed. All wood surfaces should be covered. If probe to locate galleries and drill holes to inject Drione in heavy infestation has already developed, fumigation should be used.

FLEAS AND TICKS ON DOGS AND CATS

Liberaly apply powder to the animal. Rubbing thoroughly and include the underbody, legs, feet and the base of the tail. Surfaces of kennels should be dusted at the rate of one ounce per 1000 square feet. Repeat as necessary.

DO NOT TREAT KITTENS OR PUPPIES FOUR WEEKS OLD.

SOW BUGS, PILLBUGS, GROUND BEETLES, EARWIGS AND SCORPIONS:

Apply around doors and windows and other places where they enter. Treat baseboards, storage areas and other locations where they hide.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURES: Store upright at room temperature. Keep away from moisture. Sweep up and dispose of with chemical waste.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in same manner.

CONTAINERS ONE POUND AND SMALLER: Do not reuse container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
