Labeling Amendments, Alternate Formulation and Additional Subject:

Brand Names

CIC Residual Insecticide No. 1 EPA Registration No. 50404-3

Your Submission Dated June 15, 1993

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling change listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- 1. Under Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals delete the statement "Do not allow use by small children without close adult supervision." This conflicts with Keep Out of Reach of Children. Children, regardless of age or supervision, should not be allowed to apply pesticides.
- Delete the use pattern "On Pet Livestock." The livestock 2. use pattern is not acceptable for homeowner use products. We are not convinced that qualifying livestock with "pet" will restrict commercial application. The instructions are set up for commercial applicators and includes commercial sites.
- 3. Delete Ehrlichiosis from Outdoor Application. We do not have any data on this condition and it is not listed on your reference product's labeling.
- 4. Revise Environmental Hazards as follows:

This product is extremely toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms. Do not apply direct to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

- 7. Revise the term "Domestic" to "Residential" i.e., "For Indoor/Outdoor Residential Use and in Kennels."

The Confidential Statement of Formula dated April 13, 1994 for the alternate formulation is unacceptable. The certified limits of the active ingredients must be expressed as a nominal concentration. See 40 CFR 158.175 for more information.

The alternate brand names are acceptable.

INDOOR APPLICATION

For spot application only. Do not use as a space spray indoors. For home domestic use only. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food/feed should be covered or removed. Remove pets and birds, and cover fish aquaria before making surface applications. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

SURFACE SPRAYING: To control cockroaches, waterbugs, palmetto bugs, scorpions, millipedes, centipedes, sowbugs, pillbugs, ants, silverfish, firebrats, spiders, crickets, clover mites, cheese mites, granary weevils, rice weevils, confused flour beetles, rust red flour beetles, drugstore beetles, meal worms, grain mites and cadelles: Direct the spray into hiding places, cracks and crevices, behind shelves and drawers. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storages directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated lightly, keeping sprayer nossle at least 18 inches from fabric to avoid staining.

To kill lice and louse eggs: Spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect again after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches. Treat only those garments and parts of bedding, including mattresses and furniture that cannot be either laundered or dry cleaned. Allow all treated articles to dry thoroughly before use.

ON PET LIVESTOCK

To protect cattle (beef and dairy), goats, sheep, hogs and horses from horn flies, face flies, house flies, mosquitoes and gnats: Apply a light mist sufficient to wet the surface of the hair. For face flies, spray face and head, but do not spray into eyes.

To control stable flies, horse flies and deer flies: Apply at a rate of 2 ounces per adult animal, sufficient to wet hair thoroughly. Repeat treatment daily or at intervals necessary to give continued protection.

To control blood-sucking lice and ticks: Apply to the infested areas of the animal, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 3 weeks if required.

To control poultry lice: Spray roosts, walls and nests or cages thoroughly. This should be followed by spraying over the birds with a fine mist.

To control bedbugs and mites in poultry houses: Spray crevices of roost poles, cracks in walls, and cracks in nests where the bedbugs and mites hide.
