c. Based on the results of the risk assessment conducted for this formulation, this product must not be applied more than once every two weeks. Furthermore, this product has demonstrated residual protection that lasts a minimum of two weeks and holds up through several machine washings. Thus, revise the sentence "Repeat application once each week and after laundering." to

Do not retreat clothing more than once every two weeks.

d. Since exposure assessments are calculated based on how many outfits/articles of clothing are treated with one can of product, this information must be clearly stated on the label. Your label uses the term garment. What constitutes a garment? Shirt, trousers, socks? Are they all treated at the same rate, regardless of size? Based upon our exposure assessment and review of efficacy data for this type product, we suggest you revise your instructions as follows:

For protection against ticks...with a slow sweeping motion to lightly moisten the surface of the fabric holding can at a distance of 6 to 8 inches. (A complete outfit consists of shirt, trousers and socks.) Treat outer surfaces of each outfit, front and back, for 60 seconds each and allow to dry for at least 2 hours (4 hours under humid conditions). Pay particular attention to socks, trouser cuffs and shirt cuffs.

One can will treat two complete outfits. Do not exceed recommended spraying times.

e. Delete "biting flies and other biting insects" from the label or else specify what particular insects this product kills.

f. Add to the Precautionary Statements:

Do not allow use by small children without close adult supervision.

g. Change "Chemical Hazards" to "Physical or Chemical Hazards."

h. Add the statement If Swallowed as follows:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Get medical attention immediately.

i. Qualify the company name and address on the label with either "Manufactured By," or "Packed For," etc.

3. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

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### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

Do not spray directly on or otherwise allow to come in contact with skin, face, or eyes. This product is to be used as a clothing treatment only. In case of accidental spraying of skin, face or eyes, see "Statement of Practical Treatment" on side panel. Make all applications outdoors.

For protection against ticks, mosquitoes, biting flies, and other biting insects select an outdoor area protected from the wind, spray outer surfaces of clothing (while not being worn) with a slow sweeping motion, holding can at a distance of 6 to 8 inches. Treat outer surfaces of each garment, front and back, for 15 seconds each and allow 30 minutes to dry before being worn. DO NOT TREAT HEADWEAR.

Repeat application once each week and after laundering. In heavily infested areas protection from ticks will be improved by either wearing the cuffs inside footwear or taping pant cuffs around legs. Protection from mosquitoes, biting flies, and other biting insects can be further enhanced by applying an EPA approved repellent to face, hands and other exposed areas of the body.

#### DISPOSAL

Replace cap, wrap empty container in several layers of newspaper and dispose of in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
