Dear Mr. Dickens:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provision(s):

<u>Directions for Use section comment(s)</u>:

- 1. The Agency concurs with your suggestion to delete the referenced clothing statements in your rebuttal dated June 23, 2008.
- 2. Insert the following statement immediately following the 5th sentence in paragraph 1: "Do not apply this product to the outer surfaces of clothing."

Coulston Products, Inc. should note that the Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records. Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

READ AND FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS AND PRECAUTIONS ON THIS PRODUCT LABEL. Use Restrictions: Apply this product only to exposed skin as specified on this label. Do not use it near food. Do not use under clothing. Do not apply near eyes and mouth, and apply sparingly around ears. Never use repellents over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not allow children to handle this product, and do not apply to children's hands. Do not use on infants. Do not apply more than 3 times per day to children ages twelve (12) and under. [Will not damage cotton, wool or nylon.] Do not apply on or near acetate, rayon, Spandex or other synthetic fabrics (other than nylon), furniture, plastics (such as eyeglasses and watch crystals), leather and painted or varnished surfaces (including automobiles). Use of this product may cause skin or allergic reactions in rare cases. If you suspect a reaction to this product, discontinue use, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. Application: Squeeze into one hand, rub hands together and apply thoroughly in a thin layer to the forearms. Use additional lotion for upper arms. Repeat for other exposed areas. To apply to

When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin. Wipe excess from hands after applying. Avoid over-application of this product. Heavy application and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. For maximum protection, spread evenly with hand to moisten all exposed skin. If biting insects do not respond to a thin film of repellent, apply a bit more. After returning indoors wash treated skin with soap and water or bathe. This is particularly important when this product is used repeatedly in a day or on consecutive days.
