

#### WORK SAFETY RULES

Workers entering fields within 24 hours of application should were protective clothing. Reep all unprotected persons and children away from treated area or where there is danger of drift.

Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. If you feel sick in any way, STOP work and get help right away. Call a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital---immediately Explain that the victim has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition. After first aid is given (see First Aid Treatment Section) and if a doctor cannot come, take victim to clinic or hospital.

IMPORTANT! Before removing gloves, wash them with soap and water. Always wash hands, face and arms with soap and water before smoking, eating or drinking

AFTER WORK, take off all work clothes and shoes Shower, using soap and water Wear only clean clothes when leaving job. Do not wear contaminated clothing Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with soap and water after each use. Respirator should be cleaned and fifter replaced accord ing to instructions included with respirator

## POISON SIGNS (Symptoms)

Parathion is a very dangerous poison. It rapidly enters the body on contact with all skin surfaces and eves Clothing wet with this material must be removed immediately Exposed persons must receive prompt medical treatment or they may die

Some of the signs and symptoms of poisoning are Headache, nausea, vomiting, cramps weakness blurred vision, pin point pupils, tightness in chestlabored breathing, nervousness, sweating watering of eyes, drooling or frothing of mouth and nose muscle spasms and coma-

### + FIRST AID TREATMENT +

Call a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition

If breething has alogged, start artificial respiration immediately and maintain until doctor sees victim If swallowed and victim is awake (conscious) make him vomit quickly. Induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat or by giving soapy or strong sally water to drink Repeat until vomit is clear. Never give any thing by mouth to an unconscious person. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. See doctor immediately

#### NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Antidote-administer atropine sulfate in large doses TWO to FOUR mg intravenously or intramuscularly as soon as cyanosis is overcome. Repeat at 5 to 10 min. ute intervals until signs of atropinization appear 2 PAM chloride is also antidotal and may be admin. istered in conjunction with atropine DO NOT CIVE MORPHINE OR TRANQUILIZERS Parathion is a strong cholinesterase inhibitor affecting the central and peripheral nervous systems and producing cardiac and respiratory depression. At first sign of oulmonary edma, the patient should be given supple mental oxygen and treated symptomatically Confinued absorption of the poison may occur and faial relapses have been reported after initial improve ment. VERY CLOSE SUPERVISION OF THE PATIENT. IS INDICATED FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS
