**Statement of Practical Treatment**

**Directions For Use**

**GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**CHAMPION DISINFECTANT CLEANER NO. 15** is a "one-step" cleaner-disinfectant-sanitizer-fungicide-virucide in the presence of moderate amounts of organic soil.

Apply **CHAMPION DISINFECTANT CLEANER NO. 15** to walls, floors and other hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, sinks and bedframes with a cloth mop or mechanical spray device so as to thoroughly wet surfaces. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

**Disinfection** — to disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces, at 1/2 oz. per gallon of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. At this use-level, **CHAMPION DISINFECTANT CLEANER NO. 15** is also virucidal and fungicidal.

**Sanitizing** — to sanitize porous or non-porous, non-toxic contact surfaces, add 1/4 oz. per gallon of water.

1/2 oz. per gallon use-level. The broad spectrum activity of **CHAMPION DISINFECTANT CLEANER NO. 15** has been evaluated in the presence of 5% serum and found to be effective against the following by the AOAC Use-Dilution test:

- Pseudomonas aeruginosa
- Staphylococcus aureus
- Salmonella choleraesuis
- Escherichia coli
- Klebsiella pneumoniae
- Enterobacter aerogenes
- Salmonella schottmuelleri
- Streptococcus faecalis
- Shigella dysenteriae
- Brevibacterium ammoniagenes

**AOAC Fungicidal Test**

**CHAMPION DISINFECTANT CLEANER NO. 15** is effective against Trichophyton mentagrophytes (the athlete's foot fungus) when used on surfaces in areas such as lock rooms, shower and bath areas, exercise areas, dressing room, etc.

**Virucidal Performance**

At 1/2 oz. per gallon use-level, **CHAMPION DISINFECTANT CLEANER NO. 15** was evaluated in the presence of 10% serum and found to be effective against the following viruses: Herpes Simplex (a member of the virus family that causes infectious mononucleosis), Vaccinia (representative of the pox virus) and Influenza A<sub>2</sub> (the Hong Kong flu virus) on inanimate environmental surfaces.

**Sanitizing Non-Food Contact Surfaces (such as floor**

**walls, tables, etc.).** At 1/4 oz. per gallon use-level, 30 second contact time. **CHAMPION DISINFECTANT CLEANER NO. 15** is an effective sanitizing agent in waters of up to 600 pp hardness against Staphylococcus aureus and Klebsiella pneumoniae in the presence of 5% serum on porous and non-porous environmental surfaces.
