2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment.

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 50429-2."
- b. In the box beneath the ingredient statement on the front panel put "Keep out of reach of children" above "Caution."

Within 15 months of the date of this letter submit storage stability data for this product. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero and during a year of storage.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ON ANIMALS: To protect animals from *horn flies*, *house flies*, *mosquitoes* and *gnats*, apply a light mist sufficient to wet the tips of the hair. To control *stable flies*, *horse flies*, *deer flies*, apply 2 ounces per adult animal, sufficient to wet the hair, but not to soak the hide. Repeat treatment once or twice daily, or at intervals necessary to give continued protection.

To control *blood-sucking lice*, apply the spray lightly to infested areas, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Use 2 ounces or less per animal. Repeat every two or three weeks as required.

To Control Insects in Kennels and Animal Quarters: Remove pets before treating area and ventilate thoroughly before allowing them to re-enter treated area.

For rapid cleanout of *fleas* and *ticks* in kennels and animal quarters apply this product in a good machine adjusted to deliver coarse droplets. Apply to the point of runoff with special attention to cracks and crevices and other insect hiding places. Bedding should be removed and sprayed thoroughly.

To control *flies*, *mosquitoes* and *gnats* in kennels and animal quarters, apply this product in a good sprayer adjusted to deliver a fine mist. Use at the rate of approximately 1 ounce for 1000 cubic feet of space. Fill the enclosed area with mist wherever practical. Keep doors and windows closed for 10 minutes or more after application. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate after treatment is completed.
