

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. The use of this product in food processing establishments should be confined to time periods when the plant is not in operation. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquaria before spraying. Do not apply as a space spray while food processing is underway. Except in Federally inspected meat and poultry plants, when applied as a surface spray with care and in accordance with the directions and precautions given above, food processing operations may continue. Foods should be removed or covered before treatments. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. In Federally inspected meat and poultry plants, all surfaces in processing areas must be washed and rinsed in potable water after spraying. In other food processing plants, if washing of equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled, is impractical do not allow food to come in contact with treated surfaces for at least 48 hours.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as directed on the label.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. For rapid control of flies, fruit flies, gnats, mosquitoes, slipper flies, wasps, hornets, Angoumois grain moths, Mediterranean flour moths, Indian meal moths and tobacco moths.

This use of the product in food processing or food handling establishments (bakeries, beverage plants, canneries, food processing plants, hospitals, hotels, industrial installations, meat packing plants, restaurants, schools, supermarkets and warehouses) should be confined to time periods when the plants or facilities are not in operation. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before reusing.

Hospital patients should be removed for 2 hours and rooms aired before re-entry.

Close doors and windows and shut off ventilating systems. Use a mechanical aerosol generator or a fogger adjusted to deliver an aerosol spray (no droplets over 50 microns in diameter and 80% less than 30 microns). Direct the spray first into all cracks and crevices, behind all equipment, cupboards, obstructions or dark harborage areas to provide maximum penetration and impingement on the insects. Then treat as a space spray, directing the spray towards the ceiling and upper corners of the area and behind any obstructions, apply at a rate of 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for at least one hour. Vacate treated area and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment as necessary.

**SURFACE SPRAYING:** to control roaches, ants, silverfish, spiders, crickets, clover, mites, cheese mites, granary weevils, rice weevils, confused flour beetles, rust red flour beetles, sawtoothed grain beetles, spider beetles, cigarette beetles, Drugstore beetles, mealworm,
