d. Insert "Diazinon" before its chemical name and place chemical name in square brackets. Delete asterisk and its footnote. Diazinon is now an acceptable common name.		
e. Delete "1" in "isopropyl 1-6-methyl."

- f. Change double asterisk to single asterisk.
- g. Change "Application" to "Applications" in "Application of this product in food handling, etc."
- h. Start new sentence with "Apply as a spot treatment, etc." at Serving Areas.
- i. Add "This" to "DO NOT TREAT ANIMALS WITH FORMULATION."
- j. Add "Note to Physician: Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be used in conjunction with atropine."
- k. Please update the Storage and Disposal statement per PR 83-3 according to the following:

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product . . . etc.

- l. Please add separate Container Disposal statements for the plastic and metal containers.
- m. Please provide the Certification of Limits for the actives and individually added inerts as well as a brief description of the formulation process.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

For spot application only. Do not use as a space spray.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS - Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served.

FOOD AREAS - APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY.

Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing) preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups) and serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation).

To control roaches, ants, waterbugs, silverfish, spiders and crickets apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using equipment capable of delivering a pin stream of insecticide, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, in conduits, motor housings, junction or switch boxes. Prior to application de-energize electrical equipment. After application allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in "ON" position. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ARE NOT PERMITTED.

SERVING AREAS - Facilities where foods are served such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held, apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces, such as baseboards, under elements of construction and into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed.)

NON-FOOD AREAS - Including garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers) entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter. Repeat treatment as required.

CARPET BEETLES: Spray edges of carpeting and under carpeting and rugs. Make localized application to the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, closets and infested areas of shelving. Repeat as necessary.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Thoroughly spray sleeping quarters of animals. Spray infested areas around baseboards, windows and door frames, wall coverings. Applications should be repeated as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. **DO NOT TREAT ANIMALS WITH FORMULATION.**
