1. Use can upright
2. Remove actuator cap
3. Insert valve button (with tube and tip assembly attached) into valve seat.
4. Reposition actuator cap with tubing in slot.
5. Snap clip on fuel nozzle.
6. Start QUELL flow after fuel flow begins, and stop just before fuel flow ceases.
7. To start QUELL flow, depress actuator cap fully. To stop, offset actuator cap to one side.

USE CAUTION: Assure that QUELL is injected into flowing fuel stream. Do not permit QUELL to contact painted surface of aircraft or make contact with interior of fuel tank.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, feed or food by storage or disposal. Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
