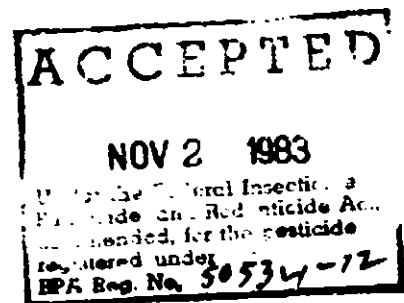
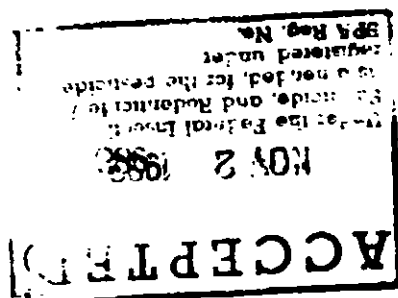

## Directions for Use

### General Classification

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

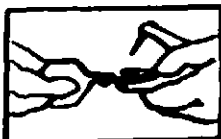

Place female tag under clip by depressing lever. Cut on tag must be pointing down.

Slide male button on pin until it projects through tip. Tag and button are now ready for application. Shaded plus and minus signs for application.

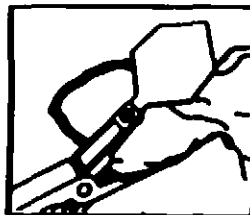

Position tag on the flat surface in center of ear. Do not allow shaft of the male button to penetrate any cartilage rib or blood vessel. Ear damage may result.

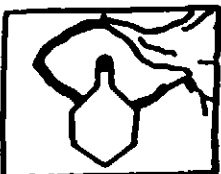

When properly positioned, the tag should hang as shown.

### Use Directions

For optimum pest control, attach one tag to each ear when pests first appear. Tags may remain effective for up to 6-8 months (horn flies). Replace as necessary. Apply with the Affix Tagging System.
